WHAT IS THE NEW BIRTH?

Our Sunday evening King's Academy class is focusing on the new birth or the biblical doctrine of regeneration. I want to share a few things we have gleaned so far in our study.

The primary biblical text on the new birth is John 3:3-8, in which Christ told Nicodemus that a person cannot see or enter the kingdom of God unless he is born again. He said, "Do not marvel that I said to you, you must be born again" (John 3:7). That is a very emphatic and clear message. The new birth is essential, not optional. It is the necessary gateway to the kingdom of God. Without the new birth there is no salvation and eternal life.

Regeneration or the new birth is the work of God in which He implants new life into the spiritually dead soul. It is a total transformation of the person on the inside. It is spiritual rebirth. It is the life of God in the soul of man. In regeneration we are raised from being dead in trespasses and sins (Eph. 2:1) into being alive in Christ (2 Cor. 5:17). In the new birth our hearts become inclined to God and the things of God. We love what we once ignored or even despised and we hate what we used to love.

The new birth enables us to understand our need for a new heart. God also enables us to comprehend who Christ is, what He has provided, and to recognize that salvation is by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone. No one is born a Christian. All people need to be born again (literally, "from above").

Regeneration is an act of God that occurs instantly, not a process that occurs over time. This act of God in the soul accomplishes what a physical birth cannot. When a person is born again he is given a new spiritual beginning with a new heart, will, and destiny.

God uses biblical truth as seed to bring this new life to our souls. The Word of God must be planted within the heart. Only a supernatural book can be used by God to bring about the supernatural birth that is needed to bring supernatural life into human souls. No one is born independently of the Word of God.

These are but a few of the rich truths we have gleaned so far in our study of the new birth. It's not too late to participate in our King's Academy class. We have eight sessions remaining and we invite you to join us Sundays at 5:45 PM.


Points of Interest




